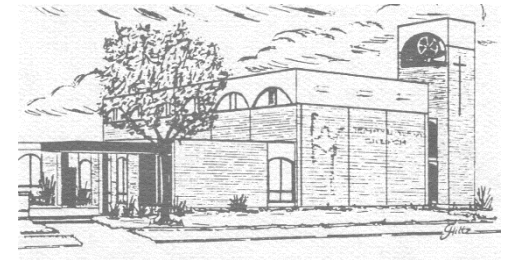

### Luke 17:11 (NRSV)

#### Jesus Cleanses Ten Lepers

<sup>11</sup> On the way to Jerusalem Jesus <sup>12</sup> was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup> As he entered a village, ten lepers <sup>13</sup> approached him. Keeping their distance, <sup>13</sup> they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" <sup>14</sup> When he saw them, he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were made clean. <sup>15</sup> Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. <sup>16</sup> He prostrated himself at Jesus' <sup>16</sup> feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup> Then Jesus asked, "Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they?" <sup>18</sup> Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup> Then he said to him, "Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well."

<sup>17</sup> — ¿Acaso no quedaron limpios los diez? — preguntó Jesús—. ¿Dónde están los otros nueve? <sup>18</sup> ¿No hubo ninguno que regresara a dar gloria a Dios, excepto este extranjero? <sup>19</sup> Levántate y vete —le dijo al hombre—; tu fe te ha sanado.
