Mennonite World Conference

Latin America: From Venezuela to Colombia, Guatemala, Mexico and more, government policies, economic hardships, and natural disasters are causing forced migration and displacement within and between Latin American countries. Churches mourn the loss of members who leave and open their hands and hearts to the new people who arrive in the community with needs and opportunities. Pray for resilience found in the hope of the gospel and the sustaining power of the Holy Spirit.

Africa: Zimbabwe recently came out of peaceful elections for which we are thankful. Pray that the new leadership would work diligently toward the economic recovery that still seems far off. Lack of basic commodities cause long, chaotic queues for meagre supplies. There is unprecedented frustration with outbreaks of violence, including an attack resulting in death for a Brethren in Christ Church lay leader at Esigodini. Pray for a holistic peace in Zimbabwe.

Latin America: Pray that the church in Puerto Rico may be strengthened. The church there has suffered a lot recently due to natural disasters that have occasioned great losses.
