**December 22<sup>nd</sup>** is the Spanish Service Christmas Celebration. Come and join them, with a Christmas dinner following the service.

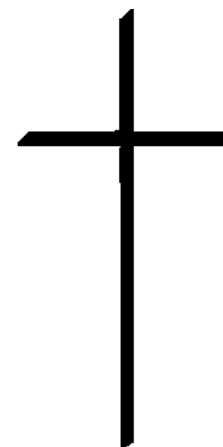
**December 23<sup>rd</sup>**- Will be our annual Christmas desserts and snacks potluck after the service. Bring your favourite sweet or savoury treat to share!
